LET WESLEY FOUNDATION HELP YOU CLEAN WITH YOUR SPRING

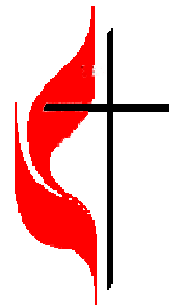
